During 7 days participants will have a possibility to photograph wildlife of Polish marshes such as moose, storks, wild birds as well as other animals and various landscapes.

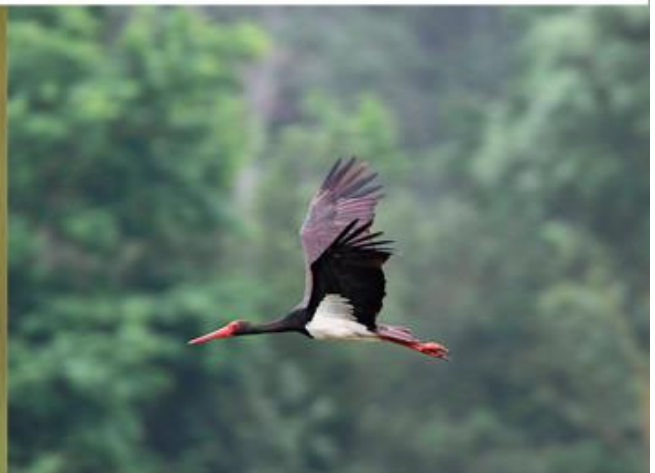

Participants arriving by plane can rent a car at the airport, or travel by bus from Warsaw Chopin Airport to Jezewo Stare (about 180 km - 2 h 15 min by bus) in the direction to Białystok. From Jezewo Stare they will be transported to the hotel Dobarz

(35 km, 30 min. by car).

Additional cost for ballooning is 120 euro.
